3. Walking or Ride-on devices

The ride-on machine is a great option if the floor scrubber you require is for big spaces like for example retail interiors or inside of warehouses. This model allows the worker to steer the machine around obstructions and corners efficiently and easily in view of the fact that the driver has a good vantage point. These kinds of floor scrubbing machinery come equipped with a 250L water tank plus an equivalent container to gather the filthy water. Walking devices are similar models which could be operated by anyone walking behind the machine and maneuvering the scrubber.
